Meeting called to order: 1:15 pm Motion to accept meeting agenda Helen Anne Girouard. Seconded Niki Parry. Passed.

Information Items:

Discussion items:

1. Budget

- finances are in good order
- actual expenses and projected budget items are all very close
- there are no areas in which we are significantly over budget
- waiting on Canada Summer Jobs funding and the final payments from Lotteries and Youth Investment funds that we will receive when final project reports are submitted

Motion made by Helen Anne Girouard for Flatwater North for Coach Lynwen's Competition development evaluation (\$350) from the budget line of Coaching Development. Seconded Niki P. Passed.

Staffing update

- Lynwen will not be returning to Whitehorse after Nationals. Her contract will end on September 6 (instead of September 13). In the time after Nationals she will do final reports, recommendations and prepares fall cross-training programmes for the athletes.
- Will discuss staffing needs in Dec/Jan to be in a position to hire coaches for next summer early in new year

Fall programming

 Plan for fall training program same as last winter : Tuesday and Thursday 4:30 – 5:30 pm at CGC. Program fee \$350 (includes entry to CGC for those who need it).

October 2 – December 12 = \$350 January 7 – April 30 (excluding spring break) = \$480

- Daniel will supervise the athletes in the gym (will periodically ask for substitute when he can't attend)
- Lynwen and Daniel will design programs for the youth to do weights which will include a cardio component that can be done on their own time outside of the Tuesday/Thursday work outs

- **Maple Ridge** all details are good. Travelling on Sept 6-8. Lotteries travel funds were allocated to those who have not traveled yet this summer and to one adult
- **Icebreaker** suggestion to have a vehicle stay at start and then go to the McRae put-in in case there is need for participants to return or get off the river, suggestion to have mandatory gear/equipment for the weather, good learning for our young paddlers about being prepared for all conditions
- **Chili and Beans** need to have designated registration/membership person, put forms online for people to do ahead of time, Pat McKenna will give materials/equipment for Chili and Bean race to club to store, parents will need to step up to help with food prep next year as Pat will not be able to
- **Circuit Races** 3 circuit races, attendance low for them, mostly club athletes and a few regulars, would be ideal to have the circuit race at Schwatka as it would be logistically easier, excellent paddling practice for the sprint athletes for long distance races at regattas
- Paddle-Cross was excellent must do again Jake's organisation was great
- **Championships** went well, lower attendance than in the past, the core group of paddlers were there and it ran as a real regatta, however, there was not as much community people coming out, advertising was lacking, should have advertised on radio and to the wider community
- Voyageur/Dragon Boat suggestion to have a new race for voyageurs and dragon boat
