Meeting called to order at 6:35 by Helen Anne

Accept meeting agenda. Motion Helen Anne. Seconded Kim. Passed.
Accept Minutes of January 12, 2017 executive meeting. Motion: Helen Anne. Seconded Niki. Passed.

Information/discussion:

- 1. Thanks! For all the time, energy, thought and hard work that has gone in to the creation of the Flatwateryukon.ca website. Things are moving along great and everyone has been working tirelessly to be ready for the launch date of February 19, 2017.
- 2. Website questions/discussion (Kim & Matt)
 - Agreed that CK registration for each of the CanoeKids camps will be separately for each week. This is not necessarily the best option for users, but definitely the best for us to be using in the back ground (ex. For camper lists, contacts, receipts, etc.) Kim and Matt will continue the discussion with Jaden (Sportical) to see if there can be changes to the registration process that makes it easier for parents to sign up kids for multiple events.
- 3. Membership discussion: what does membership include, cost, who, etc. (Niki)
 - Niki proposed options for membership prices and groupings. The wording details will be decided in email.
 - Points agreed on: Membership is 1 year (Oct1-Sept30), CanoeKids membership cost is included in price of camp so parents do not have to make the extra step to pay for membership. Regatta Ready/Sprint participants must be Junior members. Senior members are adults who are voting members.
 - Logistically on the Sportical site: for people signing up for programming, there will be a button to confirm that you are a member of FPY before signing up. We will us the program lists to confirm that participants are actually members before commencement of programming.
 - Membership will be listed as an "event" on Sportical and participants will be directed to pay for membership on the site.

6. Canada Games update (Dan)

FPY can send 2 coaches, a Manager (stays with athletes at the village) and a Chef de mission (liaison person from Sport Yukon to sport, stays off site with the Sport Yukon Officials). Team numbers for athletes and support team needs to be submitted to Sport Yukon in the next week. Dan to communicate with Sport Yukon to confirm team.

7. Florida Training Camp (Dan)

Opportunity for Daniel and competitive sprint athletes to travel to Pointe-Claire Canoe Club spring training camp in Good Counsel Camp in Florida. Dates to be confirmed. Cost for the week at the camp approx. \$330 for two weeks.
